



## BOOKING POLICY

- A Booking Deposit is required to confirm your reservation. The Booking Deposit includes: 33% of the yacht rate and instructor fees (if any) and 100% of the Yacht Damage Waiver (see below).
- The Yacht Damage Waiver may be waived with the YDW Release Form which can be downloaded from the web site.
- The remaining balance and Wisconsin state sales tax are due on or before the first day of charter.

## CHANGE AND CANCELLATION POLICIES

### CHANGE POLICY

- Once you've confirmed your reservation, you may make a change of dates or boat to an existing booking 46 days or greater prior to the first day of charter for a \$50 administration fee, except for the following boats which will incur a fee of the entire Booking Deposit if the change is made after June 1: the Jeanneau 44, 49, 50 and the Lagoon 380.
- A change of boat on an existing booking 45 days or less prior to the first day of charter must be considered a cancellation and will incur any fees outlined in the Cancellation Policy.

### CANCELLATION POLICY

- If you cancel any or all charter days 46 days or more prior to the first day of charter, the Booking Deposit shall be refunded less a \$50 administrative fee, except for the following boats which will incur a fee of the entire Booking Deposit if the change is made after June 1: the Jeanneau 44, 49, 50 and the Lagoon 380.
- If you cancel any or all charter days 45 to 31 days prior to the first day of charter, you forfeit your Booking Deposit.
- If you cancel any or all charter days 30 days or less prior to the charter start date, you remain liable for 100% of all fees.

## YACHT DAMAGE WAIVER / SECURITY DEPOSIT

Your yacht will be insured by the yacht's owner subject to the insurance policy deductible which varies from boat to boat and is based on hull value of the boat. The charterer's liability for loss of or damage to the yacht or its equipment will be limited to the insurance deductible amount.

Superior Charters offers an optional Yacht Damage Waiver to protect you and your crew in the event of loss or damage to the yacht or its equipment (damage includes excessive dirt and debris left on the boat after charter). You may select one of the following two options for your charter booking:

- Option 1. YACHT DAMAGE WAIVER (YDW).** A \$29 per day fee for monohulls up to 38' and \$37 per day fee for monohulls 39' and over and catamarans. This reduces your liability to \$500 or \$1000 respectively. A current credit card number on file will be required to secure this amount.
- Option 2. SECURITY DEPOSIT.** A refundable security deposit of \$2,500 up to \$4,000, depending on boat size, payable in cash or check. This security deposit can be applied to the repair of damages, loss of equipment, cleaning or cancellation fees. This deposit does not relieve the charterer of loss or damage over the amount of the deposit, as described in the Yacht Charter Agreement.

Should you elect to waive the Yacht Damage Waiver, the refundable security deposit is due, via cash or check, 45 days prior to the first day of charter. The YDW per day fee will be credited towards the balance due once the security deposit is received. The security deposit will be refunded one month after termination of the charter in the event of no loss or damages.

## TRAVEL INSURANCE

Superior Charters has partnered with Global Alert to offer trip insurance for you and your party.
